- Student-run organization that publishes scholarly articles from professors and legal scholars across the country and world.
- Publishes a select number of student articles

Jurimetrics: The Journal of Law, Science, and Technology

- Oldest Journal dedicated to topics in law, science, and technology in the United States (1959)
- Most circulated peer-reviewed journal in its field, with a circulation of over 8,700 hard copies per quarterly issue

 - ASU's Center for Law, Science & Innovation
- Wide range of topics covered
- Frequently cited in textbooks, legal treatises, scholarly articles in a wide range of other journals, and opinions at all levels of the state and federal judiciary—including the United States Supreme Court (e.g., Daubert v. Merrell Dow Pharmaceuticals, Inc. & Perry v. New Hampshire)

How to prepare in the meantime...

- Breathe.
- Look through your Bluebook and "tab" rules as you go.
 - Remember: Law journals use the white pages, not bluepages.
- Review your first semester memos. Understand CREAC, IRAC, etc.
- Attend mandatory second meeting on March 12, and take notes on the Bluebook Hints presentation.
